



## CHEF'S MASTER CLASS WINE LIST

### **2012 Prosecco La Marca, Brut NV, Veneto, ITL • 45**

A beautiful crisp palate with notes of ripe lemon, green apple, grapefruit, and a hint of honeysuckle.

### **2002 Moscato La Perlina, Veneto, ITL • 41**

This deliciously sweet, semi-sparkling wine offers notes of orange blossom, peach, and nectarine.

### **2011 Chardonnay Ferrari-Carano, Sonoma, 2017 CA • 42**

Deliciously complex and full bodied with rich flavors of apple, cinnamon, and hazelnut with toasted notes that round out the creamy buttery lingering finish.

### **Chardonnay Andiamo, Rutherford, 2017 • 22**

Comforting notes of baked apple pie with toasted oak notes of caramel and spice.

### **2301 Gavi Enrico Serafino, "Grifo Del Quartaro", Piedmonte, 2018 ITL • 33**

If you like Sauvignon Blanc try Gavi it has notes of sliced green apples, citrus and peach. Bright and zippy with a perfect finish.

### **2705 Pinot Noir Elk Cove, Willamette Valley, 2017 OR • 45**

Raspberry and dark cherry lead into woody aromas of mushroom, violet, and thyme. Full and very fruit forward with a long finish.

### **2602 Chianti Classico Riserva Ruffino, "Ducale Oro", Tuscany, 2016 ITL • 65**

Intense aromas of violet, blackberry, cherry, and ripe plum with intriguing notes of cinnamon and clove. Classic elegance and style with a lingering finish of chocolate and coffee.

### **2708 Red Blend Paoletti "Piccolo Cru", Napa, 2017 CA • 41**

A Bordeaux blend of exceptional quality. One hundred percent estate fruit that is complex and elegant. Well integrated black cherry, warm spice, smokey oak, and supple tannins. Rich and intriguing.

### **Cabernet Sauvignon, Andiamo, Napa Valley, 2018 • 25**

Ripe currant, fresh Bing cherry, dark plum, with a hint of sage. Full-bodied with soft tannins, a velvety mouthfeel and a long, lingering finish.

### **2614 Barolo Andrea Oberto, Piedmonte, 2015 ITL • 74**

Poached and spiced red cherries and red plums, with a walnut-like sheen of more savory aromas. There's a bed of fine tannins, which holds bright and juicy red fruit flavor that darkens and enriches the deep, long finish.

### **2718 Red Blend Daou "Pessimist" (Syrah, Petit Sirah, Zinfandel), Paso Robles, 2018 CA • 60**

Bright and vibrant on the palate, flavors of cherry, cranberry, and pomegranate dance on the tongue. Multi-layered with a lovely silky texture coupled with a cinnamon spiciness produces a mouth-watering experience. Sip and enjoy.
